Dynon First in Rochie While Bone Takes Charge of Series Lead

Myer Bendigo Manager Paul Dynon soloed to an exciting victory in Rochester. He broke clear of the bunch with a kilometer to go and caught the the rest of the field napping on the new finishing route. Mick Anderson and Phil Bone lead home the bunch.

The scratch markers were the biggest losers of the day. After 45km the bunches turned at Milloo with 6 minutes between limit and scratch. The race looked like a gift to scratch but a tail wind came into play blowing the front markers towards the finish in Rochester. But the next turn saw the wind almost stop, completely disadvantaging the scratch bunch. Shepparton rider Travis Edwards collected the prize scalp of Pelé in the sprint for fastest time a minute behind the leaders.

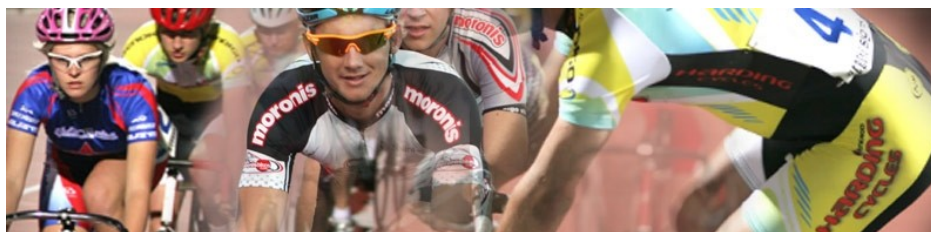
